Personal eating gear (fork, knife, spoon)

Sleeping bag or blankets

Shower shoes (for shower use only)

Flashlight with spare batteries

Bug Spray & Sun Block

Sewing Kit

Personal First Aid Kit

Mirror (Metal) Wristwatch

Required/prescribed medication

Any item to make your stay comfortable
